

Overview

Every year, **Trinity Kids** continues building relationships through our **ConnecTeen** program with children who have attended one or more weeks of a **Royal Family KIDS** camp operated by our organization. This program was designed specifically with teenagers (12-18) in mind and focuses on special event outings that will entertain them, provide learning opportunities, and promote appropriate and positive relationships with Trinity Kids' volunteers.

Although there are not as many volunteer positions as our other programs might offer, **ConnecTeen** needs passionate individuals who work well with teenagers to help out with these events. As a volunteer who works with children in our organization, you will be required to complete a volunteer application, pass a background check, and be interviewed by our executive directors and other staff members.

Positions

- **Event Planner** – develops the annual event plan, coordinates all facets of the activities, and schedules with event facilities and volunteers to create a successful event
- **Chaperone** – provide support for all events as required by joining the teenagers and other Chaperones as part of each outing
- **Small Group Leader** – lead a small group of Chaperones and children in order to promote stronger relationship building and life skills with a faith-based approach
- **Photographer** – must offer photography skills better than an amateur photographer and assume responsibility for all still- and live-action photography as part of each **ConnecTeen** outing
